Dear Mr. Famie:

Thank you for contacting the Yankee Air Museum to inquire about using the Boeing B-17G Flying Fortress, Yankee Lady, and our leased hangar space in your motion picture. The appearance of the aircraft would be subject to an aircraft use agreement and permission Yankee Air Museum would seek to obtain, through the Wayne County Airport Authority, for the use of the Hangar 1 ramp. Yankee Air Museum would supply all necessary staff to support the aircraft during the filming. Participation would be limited only to essential people.

Yankee Air Museum will make the B-17G Yankee Lady available for one day (9:00AM to 5:00PM), either Saturday, September 26 or Sunday, September 27, or Saturday, October 3, or Sunday October 4, 2020. The cost of this rental would be \$7500.00. Additional amenities for your crew or cast would be at your expense.

The B-17 Flying Fortress is 74 ft. 4 in. long and has a wingspan of 103 ft. 9 in. It is 19 ft. 1 in. tall and weighs approximately 34,000 pounds empty.

Yankee Air Museum will require a 50% deposit (\$3750.00) by March 20, 2020 to continue to hold the availability of the aircraft. A payment of 25% will be due upon signing of the aircraft use agreement (\$1875.00) not later than May 29, 2020 and the balance on the day of the filming. Deposit dollars paid after the aircraft use agreement is signed are not refundable.

Thank you for your interest in the B-17G, Yankee Lady.
